

The Department of Physics at Rutgers University – Camden is accepting applications for an annually appointed full-time Assistant Instructor position to begin on 9/1/2012. The responsibilities will include teaching lower and upper level undergraduate laboratory sections and courses, maintaining the laboratory stock room and equipment, and working with departmental faculty to ensure the most up-to-date pedagogical practices are utilized in the laboratories. The normal teaching load for this position is 5 laboratory sections -or- 1 course and 3 laboratory sections. A Bachelor's degree in Physics or a closely related field is required and previous laboratory teaching experience is desirable.
