Your first step: accept your offer of admission.

1. ACCEPT YOUR ADMISSION OFFER

- Say “yes” to Rutgers–Camden at gradstudy.rutgers.edu/status.
- Connect with Your Graduate Program
Reach out to your program director to let them know you have accepted the offer of admission and discuss next steps: graduateschool.camden.rutgers.edu/contact/graduate-directors.

2. GET RAPTOR READY

- Activate Your NetID
After accepting your admission, your next step is to activate your NetID at netid.rutgers.edu. You'll use your NetID to access your Rutgers email, myRutgers portal, housing and dining applications, and other services.
- Complete Your Financial Aid Application
If you have not applied, we recommend submitting your Free Application for Federal Student Aid at fafsa.gov as soon as possible. Rutgers' federal school code is 002629.
- Check Your Financial Aid Status
If you have submitted your FAFSA, you can check your documents and award status to ensure that all information is accurate at financialaid.rutgers.edu.
- Submit All Final Transcripts
Please mail your official transcript(s) from all institutions attended to the Office of Graduate and Undergraduate Admissions. Official electronic transcripts may be sent to e-transcripts@camden.rutgers.edu.

3. GET READY FOR CLASS

- Advising and Registration
Meet with your faculty advisor and/or program director and register for classes online at sims.rutgers.edu/webreg.
- Confirm Attendance and Pay Your Term Bill
After you have registered for courses, you can access your term bill at studentabc.rutgers.edu. Students will not receive a term bill in the mail. To confirm your attendance, complete the RUHere process: financialaid.rutgers.edu/ruhere-confirmation-of-attendance-process.
- Access MyRutgers Portal
With your NetID, you can access my.rutgers.edu to check your Rutgers email, select and view courses, access your course schedule and term grades, and much more.
- Enroll in or Waive Health Insurance
Health insurance is available to all students. You may also enroll in or waive coverage at riskmanagement.rutgers.edu/student-health-insurance.
